QUICK ACCESS TO GENERAL DELMONT DAY PROGRAM (DDP)

The GP Direct Referral to Day Program provides prompt entry for low-risk patients suitable for shared care (who do not require continuous management by a psychiatrist). It helps GPs get timely support for their patients, with the patient being allocated to the appropriate Day Program based on their needs. This pathway is designed for patients who meet the following criteria:

- **Clinically Suitable:** Patients who do not require continuous care from a psychiatrist and can be managed through a shared care model between the treating GP and Delmont Private Hospital
- **Ideal for patients who are not in need of an urgent inpatient admission.**
- **Regular Attendance is essential**
- **Private Health Insurance: Required**

Acknowledgement of receipt of the referral will be sent by email within 5 working days.

Following the 291 assessment a detailed report with your patient's treatment plan will be forwarded to the treating GP. The therapy team will correspond directly with the treating GP where required and provide quarterly reviews on the patient's progress.

Delmont Private Hospital does not offer emergency services. Patients in need of urgent treatment should go to the nearest Emergency Department.
